Hereinafter we inform you which information we collect on our websites, for which purposes they are used and whom we potentially share this information with.

Personal information collected from you

Personal information is any information which allows the identification of your person.

We collect personal information (e.g. name, address, phone number or email address) in the connection with the operation of our websites only when you voluntarily provide such information to us (by contact enquiries, newsletter registrations, online orders etc.) and when we are entitled to process or use such information by virtue of your consent.

Personal information will only be used by us for the purpose for which you provided it to us or which is legitimized by a statutory provision. For example, to process your orders, answer your inquiries or grant you access to certain information and offerings.

Google Analytics

We make use of Google Analytics, a web analytics service provided by Google, Inc (“Google”). Google Analytics uses “cookies”, which are text files placed on your computer, to help the website analyse how users use the site. The information generated by the cookie about your use of the website (including your IP address) will generally be transmitted to and stored by Google on servers in the United States. In case of activation of the IP anonymisation, Google will truncate / anonymise the last octet of your IP address for Member States of the European Union as well as for other parties to the Agreement on the European Economic Area. Only in exceptional cases will the full IP address be transmitted to a Google server in the USA, where it will be abbreviated. At the request of the website provider, Google will use this information for the purpose of evaluating your use of the website, compiling reports on website activity for website operators and providing other services relating to website activity and internet usage to the website provider. Your IP address will not be associated with other Google data. You may refuse the use of cookies by selecting the appropriate settings on your browser; however, please note that if you do this, you may not be able to use the full functionality of this website. In addition, you can prevent Google’s collection and use of the data (cookies and IP address), as well as the processing of this data by Google, by downloading and installing the browser plug-in available from the following link:
